RV Parking and Camping Information for Strawberry Cup Pleasant Valley Fields sports park

Camarillo, California

RV Parking Overview:

Pleasant Valley Recreation and Park District (PVRPD) <u>does not</u> allow RV parking within Pleasant Valley Fields (PVF) sports park. However, during the tournament RV's can be parked on the two adjoining city streets (Village at the Park Drive and Westpark Court). These two city streets can hold a total of some 200 vehicles near the sports park. Note that the City of Camarillo does not allow RV parking on city streets Monday through Friday from 10 AM to 4 PM (need permit from city during these hours).

Overnight RV Camping:

The City of Camarillo <u>does not allow overnight camping on city streets on any night</u>. So RV's can be parked overnight on city streets but can not be occupied overnight. However the PVRPD does allow 'dry camping' at Freedom Park for RV's used during PVRPD activities.

If interested in RV 'dry camping' at Freedom Park please contact AYSO volunteer Mike Mishler by the Wednesday before the tournament. Freedom Park 'dry camping' cost is \$30 per night. Mike Mishler will purchase the required PVRPD 'dry camping' tickets on Thursday before the tournament and meet you on Saturday to transfer the ticket and receive the payment. Note that Freedom Park was the site for previous Strawberry Tournaments and is located on Pleasant Valley Road a few miles to the west of PVF sports park.
